Facility overview: HealthEast Sports Center (HSC), [formerly Bielenberg Sports Center](#), is one of the largest multiuse sports centers in the state. HSC serves the community and region with high-quality indoor and outdoor facilities, including a 90,000-square-foot indoor field house, two indoor ice arenas, an outdoor refrigerated recreational ice skating rink, 36 outdoor athletic fields and a splash pad water feature. It is home to three local high school hockey teams and Madison's Place, the Twin Cities East Metro's first completely handicapped-accessible inclusive playground.

Project Overview: HSC houses two sheets of ice, and Becker Arena Products, Inc. was selected to replace boards on the West rink. This project included removal and trade-in of the existing dasher system before the installation of the new dasher system. The rink features powder blue kick plate and black cap rail and poly backer. 6' glass was installed around the rink and protective netting was added to the spectator bleacher side of the rink to maximize safety.



Products/Supplies: One BAP6.0 *Signature Series* Dasher Board System 200' x 85' with a combination posted and *Vision* supportless shielding system, tempered glass and puck control netting.

"Our west rink is a sand floor. To make it easier, the dasher installation was done with the ice in," says [Katie Broderick](#), Facility Operations Technician at HealthEast Sports Center. "It was a very interesting process to observe, watching them dismantle the old and install the new system piece by piece. This is a great improvement for our facility and our customers."
