

HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT FLOORING FOR YOUR FACILITY

It is not always about budget, although that is sometimes the driver. Other considerations are environmental conditions, application and installation. Discuss with your Becker Arena Products Inc. START BY ASKING THESE SIX QUESTIONS

PLAN AHEAD

- 1. Is there a budget dollar range you are working within?
- 2. What is the total square footage you need to cover?
- 3. What kind of look are you trying to convey?
- 4. How long does this surface need to last? (or how long do you want it to last)
- 5. How is the room/area being used? (skate or foot traffic, fitness)
- 6. Tell us about the room/area location. (temperature, moisture)

WHAT THICKNESS DO I NEED?

There are recommended industry standards based on your application. Becker Arena Products Inc. offers product in several thicknesses required for both ice rink skate traffic, foot traffic, training/weight rooms and fitness centers.

LOOSE LAY OR GLUE DOWN?

The decision to loose lay or glue down your flooring may depend on your application. Most indoor ice rinks will glue down their flooring. A benefit to a glue down application is to prevent the floor from moving and getting moisture underneath. If you have an area that is multipurpose, you may want to consider a loose lay or interlocking application so the floor can easily be pulled up and stored.

WHAT IS MOISTURE MITIGATION?

Moisture mitigation can be a necessary process for ice rinks during a renovation or new construction project to prepare your surface before flooring installation. It is vital that a moisture test be completed prior to floor installation. Moisture is the single most significant factor that causes bonding failure to the sub-floor. Moisture tests must be taken on all concrete floors regardless of age and grade level.
